Capernaum provides homebased physical and occupational therapy for infants and children who are:

- Birth to three
- Medically complex and/or technology dependent
- In a family situation with undue hardship (e.g., parents are unable to bring their child to the clinic)
- Post-operative and/or temporarily homebound
- Homebound and have equipment needs or need an updated home exercise program

HIPAA-compliant teletherapy services are available, contingent upon insurance coverage.
